By Plane:

Brest International Airport, (Tel: +33.2 98 32 86 00 - Fax: +33.2 98 32 86 03 The is mainly linked to Paris, London, Nice, Lyon, Dublin. The primarily operator is Air France (via its subsidiary HOP!). The airport is located some 20 minutes from Brest town centre

From the airport there is a shuttle bus service to city centre.


