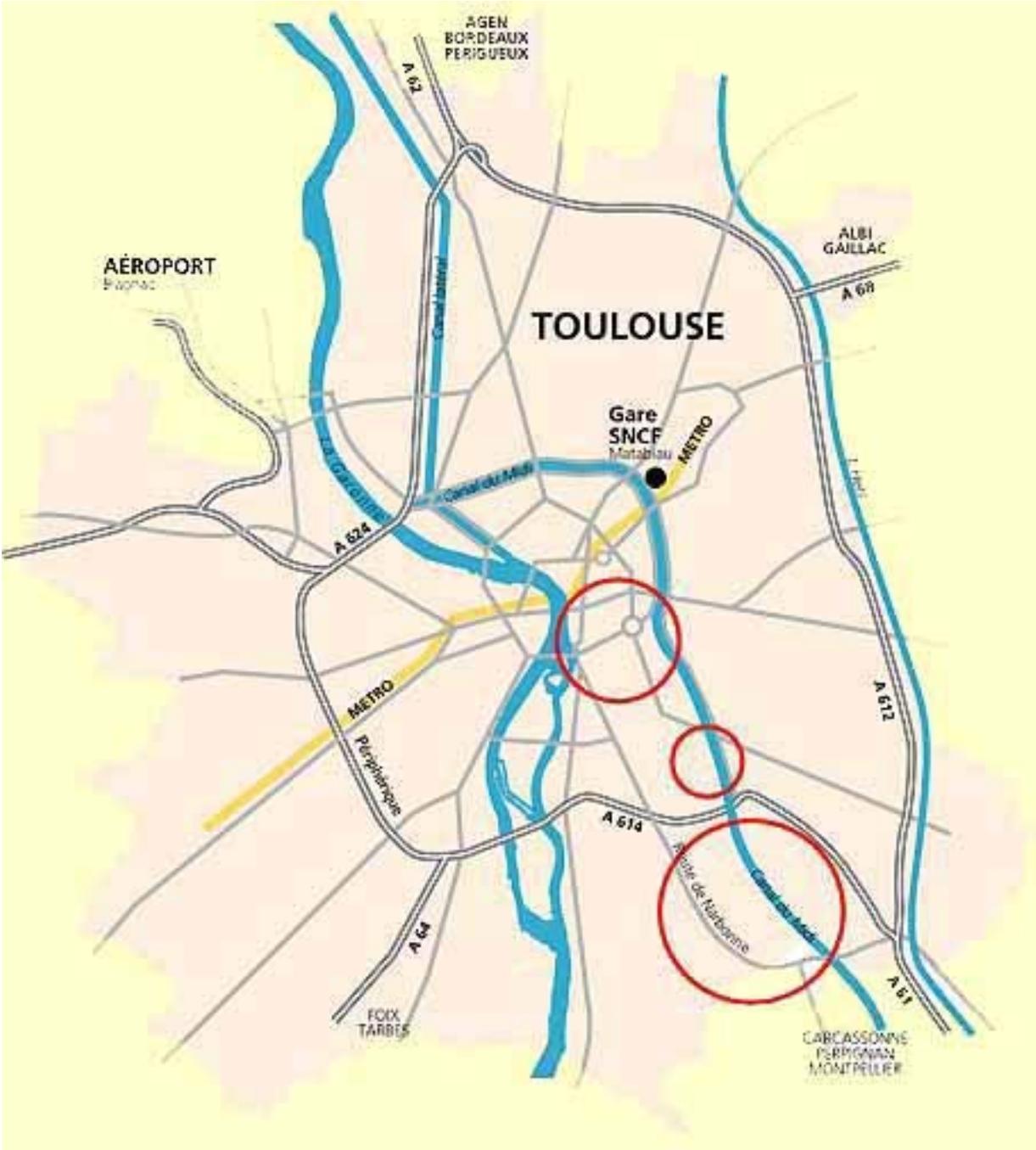

Toulouse City Centre (Shows Place du Capitole- Meeting Spot for the Conference dinner)

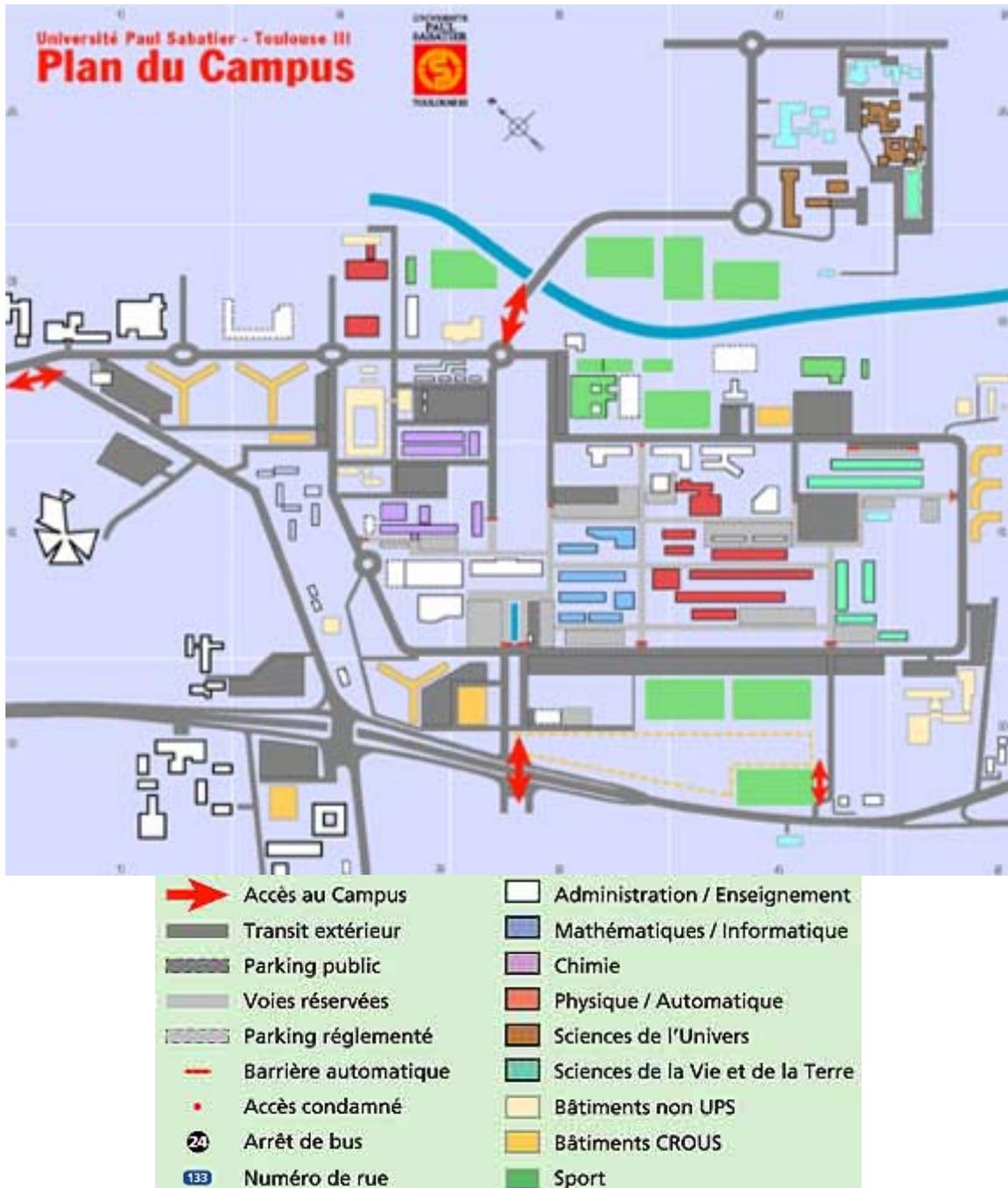

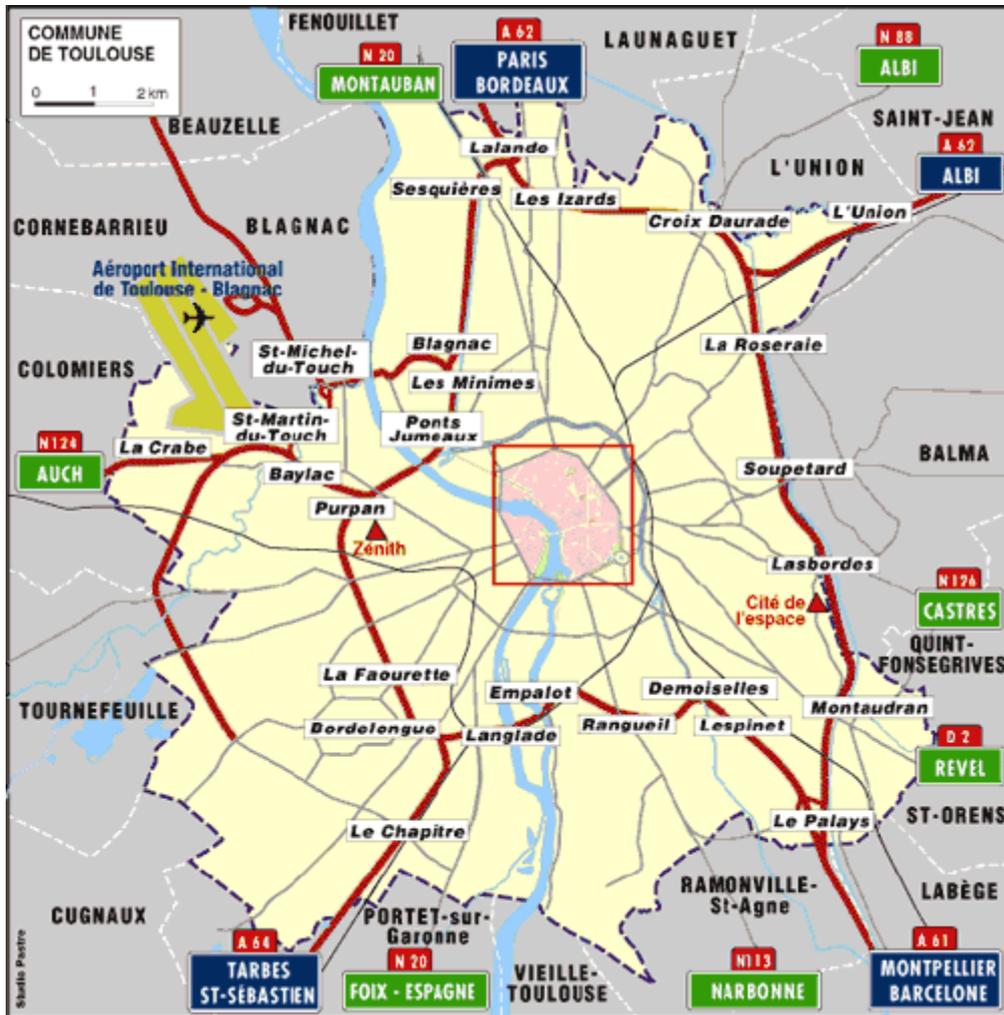
The location of Université Paul Sabatier in relation to the centre of Toulouse
